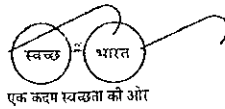

Dear Shri Prakash Javadekar Ji,

Hon'ble Prime Minister recently on 18th October 2016 launched two schemes for MSMEs at Ludhiana, Punjab. The first scheme is National Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe Hub (SC/ST Hub) and the second is Zero Defect Zero Effect (ZED) Maturity Assessment Model.

EACHE/CDN

The SC/ST Hub is the initiative of the Government targeted towards developing a supportive eco system for SC/ST entrepreneurs. The Public Procurement Policy for Central Ministries and Central Public Sector Enterprises (CPSEs) makes it mandatory to procure 20% of their total procurement goods and services from micro and small enterprises of which 4% shall be from SC/ST enterprises. The SC/ST Hub will facilitate achievement of this objective of SC/ST enterprises supplying at least 4% of goods and services in public procurement. The SC/ST Hub would work with State Governments, industry associations, SC/ST enterprises, CPSEs and Central Ministries, private industry and other stakeholders to fulfill this objective. Government has also sanctioned a scheme for Rs.490 crores till 2019-20 to support the SC/ST Hub. A copy of the Action Plan giving details of the SC/ST Hub is enclosed.

Hon'ble Prime Minister in his speech on August 15, 2014 had asked Indian industry to adopt Zero Defect Zero Effect (ZED) manufacturing to support sustainable 'Make in India' Initiative. ZED Scheme is an extensive drive to create awareness in MSMEs about ZED manufacturing and motivate them for assessment of their enterprises for ZED and support them. After ZED assessment, MSMEs can reduce the wastages substantially, increase productivity, and expand their market in a sustainable manner. A copy of the document on Z Scheme is enclosed.

I request your support in effectively implementing the above two schemes to achieve sustainable growth for all sections of India as part of 'Make in India'. Your Ministry and CPSEs under it should support procurement from SC/ST enterprises. I also request your Ministry to support ZED initiative.
