



The CGHS Beneficiaries shall be able to avail the CGHS facilities through the Wellness Centre from 07:30 AM to 02:00 OM on all days, except Sundays and Gazetted holidays.

The CGHS Wellness Centre, Baghpat, Aligarh, Moradabad & Saharanpur shall be under the administrative control of Additional Director, CGHS, Swasthya Bhawan, S.K. Road, Meerut - 250002 (Tel. No. 0121-2601426).

2. The hospital is empanelled under CGHS on the basis of QCI recommendation. If the recommendation is withdrawn for any reason during the empanelment period, its name shall be removed from CGHS panel and 50% of performance Bank guarantee shall be forfeited.
3. This Office Memorandum and the rates applicable under CGHS, Bhopal for hospitals can be downloaded from the website of CGHS, www.cghs.gov.in.
4. This Office Memorandum is issued in pursuance of delegation of power for empanelments of private hospitals vide O.M.No.S.11045/36/2012-CGHS(HEC), dated 26.12.2017 of Department of Health and Family Welfare, Hospital Empanelment Cell, New Delhi.

Date : 13 MAY 2019

Consequent upon the merger of Postal Dispensaries located at Siliguri and Jalpaiguri with CGHS under the administrative control of Additional Director, CGHS, Kolkata on and from 01-04-2019, the above dispensaries have been rechristened as Siliguri and Jalpaiguri CGHS Wellness Centre.

As per the prevalent norms regarding jurisdiction of a CGHS Wellness Centre, which covers approximately 5 kms in radius from a particular dispensary, the demarcation of jurisdiction under Siliguri CGHS W.C. and Jalpaiguri CGHS W.C. have been finalized as per the Annexures attached for these two Wellness Centre separately as mentioned under :-

- (a) Annexure I for Siliguri CGHS W.C.
- (b) Annexure II for Jalpaiguri CGHS W.C.

The Administration of all Central Government Offices located in the city of Siliguri and Jalpaiguri must compulsorily deduct CGHS contribution from the salary of their employees whose residential address is within the jurisdiction of CGHS Wellness Centre in these two cities and this is not linked to the application for CGHS Cards by the concerned employees.

Central Government Pensioners residing within the area of jurisdiction may avail the benefits of CGHS, but will not be eligible to draw Fixed Medical Allowance with their pension as per rules.



CIRCULAR

PFRDA/2019/12/REG-PF/1

Date: 8th May, 2019

SUBJECT: Introduction of choice of Pension Funds and Investment Pattern in Tier-I of NPS for Central Government subscribers –reg.

Reference is invited to the Gazette Notification F.No.1/3/2016-PR dated 31st January, 2019 issued by Ministry of Finance, Department of Financial Services, modifying Ministry of Finance's Notification No. 5/7/2003-ECB dated 22nd December, 2003, based on the Government's decision on the recommendations of a Committee set up to suggest measures for streamlining the implementation of National Pension System (NPS).

2. Accordingly, it has been decided to introduce the following options for Central Government subscribers:

(i) Choice of Pension Fund: As in the case of subscribers in the private sector, the Government subscribers shall also be allowed to choose any one of the pension funds including Private sector pension funds. They could change their option once in a year. However, the current provision of combination of the Public-Sector Pension Funds will be available as the default option for both existing as well as new Government subscribers.

(ii) Choice of Investment pattern: The following options for investment choices shall be offered to Government employees:

(a) The existing scheme in which funds are allocated by the PFRDA among the three Public Sector Undertaking fund managers based on their past performance in accordance with the guidelines of PFRDA for Government employees shall continue as default scheme for both existing and new subscribers.

(b) Government employees who prefer a fixed return with minimum amount of risk shall be given an option to invest 100% of the funds in Government securities (Scheme G).

(c) Government employees who prefer higher returns shall be given the options of the following two Life Cycle based schemes:

(A) Conservative Life Cycle Fund with maximum exposure to equity capped at 25% - LC-25.

(B) Moderate Life Cycle Fund with maximum exposure to equity capped at 50% - LC-50.

The subscribers may exercise one of the above choices of Investment Pattern twice in a financial year.

(iii) Implementation of choices to the legacy corpus: Transfer of a huge legacy corpus of more than Rs. 1 lakh crore in respect of the Government sector subscribers from the existing Pension Fund Managers is likely to impact the market. It may be practically difficult for the PFRDA to allow Government subscribers to change the Pension Funds or investment pattern in respect of the accumulated corpus, in one go. Therefore, for the present, change in the Pension Funds or investment pattern is allowed in respect of incremental flows only.

(iv) Transfer of legacy corpus in a reasonable time frame: PFRDA shall draw up a scheme in due course for transfer of accumulated corpus as per new choices of Government subscribers in a reasonable time frame of say five years. Once PFRDA draws up this scheme, change in the Pension Funds or investment pattern shall be allowed in respect of the accumulated corpus in accordance with that scheme.

3. For investment option as per para 2 (ii) (a) above, all other terms and conditions as contained in the investment guidelines issued by the Authority dated 03.06.2015 for NPS Schemes (Applicable to Scheme CG, Scheme SG, Corporate CG and NPS Life Schemes and APY) and subsequent amendments made thereto shall be applicable. Further, for investment options as per para 2 (ii) (b) or 2 (ii) (c) (A) or 2 (ii) (c) (B) above, all other terms and conditions as contained in the investment guidelines issued by the Authority dated 04.05.2017 in respect of NPS Schemes (Other than Govt. Sector (CG & SG), Corporate CG, NPS Life and APY) and subsequent amendments made thereto shall apply.

4. This circular is issued in exercise of powers of the Authority under sub-clause (b) of sub-section (2) of Section 14 read with Section 23 of the PFRDA Act, 2013 and sub-regulation (1) of Regulation 14 of the PFRDA (Pension Fund) Regulations, 2015.

The above arrangements are applicable w.e.f. 1st April, 2019.

The Tables of Benefits for Savings Fund to the beneficiaries under the Central Government Employees Group Insurance Scheme-1980, which are being issued on a quarterly basis from 01.01.2017 onwards, as brought out in this Ministry's OM of even number dated 17.03.2017, for the quarter from 01.04.2019 to 30.06.2019, as worked out by IRDA based on the interest rate of 8% per annum (compounded quarterly) as notified by the Department of Economic Affairs as per their Resolution No. 5(2)-B(FD)/2019 dated 03.04.2019, are enclosed.


2. The Tables enclosed are of two categories as per the existing practice. As hitherto, the first Table of Benefits for the savings fund of the scheme is based on the subscription of Rs.10 p.m. from 1.1.1982 to 31.12.1989 and Rs.15 p.m. w.e.f. 1.1.1990 onwards. The second Table of Benefits for savings fund is based on a subscription of Rs.10 p.m. for those employees who had opted out of the revised rate of subscription w.e.f. 1.1.1990.

3. While these orders are in respect of Table of Benefits for the period from 01.04.2019 to 30.06.2019, the Tables already issued for the first quarter i.e. for the period 01.01.2019 to 31.03.2019 are also reproduced for the sake of convenience and consolidation.

4. In their application to the employees of Indian Audit and Accounts Department, these orders are issued after consultation with the Comptroller & Auditor General of India.
