Sir/Madam,

With reference to above, it is hereby informed that the National Social Science Exhibition-cum-National Integration Camp is scheduled to be held from 9th to 11th November 2016 at New Delhi. This information is being circulated to enable all regions to immediately made suitable bookings/reservations for safe and secure travel arrangements for all participants and escorts to New Delhi. The Deputy Commissioner of the host region i.e. Delhi Region will make all necessary planning and arrangements for the smooth conduct of the event. DC, KVS RO Delhi is requested to intimate details regarding various venues for events & stay of participants and their escorts to all the KVS ROs at the earliest. Expenditure as per approved budget will be reimbursed by the KVS Hgrs to Delhi Region.

This year, at National Level in the Social Science Exhibition the following competitions have been added:

On-the-spot painting, Solo singing, Sanskrit Sholaka Recitation, Hindi Kaavya Path, English Elocution, Quiz in Sanskrit (Details are in **Annexure B**)

The Regional contingent shall comprise of a maximum of 48 students as per Annexure A & B and be escorted by a maximum of 05 teachers (of which one should be a language teacher/other subjects, one a music teacher and one a teacher with Humanities background, at least two of these must be lady teachers). The regional contingent should reach the venue latest by the afternoon of 8th November, 2016. The exhibits (charts etc) should be arranged by 8th November, 2016 (A\N) at the venue so that exhibition scheduled for 9th November, 2016 morning does not get delayed. The return journey should not be planned before 6.00 PM of 11th November, 2016.

The projects will remain on display till 11th November, 2014 afternoon so that students from neighboring KV's of Delhi and Gurgaon Region are able to see the exhibits to develop a national perspective. Deputy Commissioner, Delhi can fix the time for each school to avoid overcrowding at the exhibition venue.

The Social Science Exhibition **MUST** be held at **School, Cluster and Regional level.** Selection of students, team and projects must be made judiciously. Parents, Neighboring schools, Important local personalities be invited for the Exhibition being organized at school, cluster and Regional level. The Social Science Exhibition at all levels must be conducted with enthusiasm and earnestness, so that the aim and objective of the event is fully realized.

Thus, the total no. of students in the team selected for participation at the National Social Science Exhibition will be 48 accompanied by 5 teacher escorts.

The number of students as specified above (48) should not be exceeded nor should any extra escort other than the specified 5 Teachers be sent. During the Exhibition, school uniform will be the dress code.

<u>Guidelines for conduct of Social Science Exhibition cum National Integration Camp</u>

A. Project -- Topics for project are as follows:-

- 1. Make in India
- 2. Cyber Protection
- 3. Women Empowerment
- 4. Digital India Progressive India

The following steps to be taken for writing the report of project work

- Data collection or Survey
- 2. Analysis of Data Qualitative and Quantitative
- 3. Reporting (writing)
- 4. Conclusions/predictions
- 5. Acknowledgement
- 6. Bibliography mention all references.
- 7. A certificate in the beginning claiming that the work is original signed by students, Teacher guide and principal

Project work should include the following:

Project should be a group work of 2 to 5 students. The compilation of report should be specifically 20 to 25 pages. Project should include photographs, illustration, drawing, graphs etc. The main content of Project should be primary data.

NOTE: - Project work doesn't include the following.

Preparation of charts or models by copying material from text-books / books or taking print out from internet, cut and paste information from internet should not be included in the project.

B. <u>Debate -- Topic for debate</u> (For the Regional level)

- 1. Students should take part in Politics.
- 2. Computer Education should be provided to students from Class I
- *Note -Any one topic may be chosen from the above

The topic for English/Hindi debates at National level will be uploaded on KVS(Hq) website on 2nd November,2016.

Each region will sponsor two speakers one 'for' and the other 'against' the motion separately for Hindi and English. The debate will be of 05 minute duration of which minimum 01 minute must be (repeat must be) devoted to rebuttal and repartee. The first two speakers; one 'for' and the other 'against' the motion will be given only

four minutes and one minute at the end for their share of rebuttal and repartee. The first Speaker speaking for the motion will be given one minute for rebuttal after all the speakers have spoken. The division of marks for the debate will be as follows:

Content - 30 Presentation - 40

Rebuttal & Repartee - 30 (No marks will be allowed

if rebuttal part is left untouched)

(Logic, thought, process, pronunciation, humour, confidence)

The aim of the exercise to discourage cramming and to encourage spontaneous speaking.

C. Group Dance

Group Dance to be presented by the Region must be related to the State/Country allotted to the Region. Maximum time allowed for the dance will be 06 (six) minutes including the announcement. Number of participants allowed on the stage will be six to eight and with six persons including the Music Teacher for background music and song. No person from outside KV will be allowed to play/sing. Pre-recorded cassette or any other recorded device will not be allowed. The group dance being presented will be performed in the costume of the Place/State concerned.

Marks allotted for dance is detailed below:-

Costume - 25
Co-ordinate - 25
Harmony with Music - 25
Background Music/Song - 25

D. Group Song

Duration of the Group Song will be 4-5 minute including the announcement. The number of participants allowed on the stage will be 6-8 with 04 persons including the Music Teacher for background music. The group song may be in Hindi or in the language of the State/Country allotted to the Region. The theme of the song may be patriotism, national integration, Social Cohesion, Youth/women empowerment or the folklore of the State/Country. The division of marks will be as under:-

Costume - 20 Theme - 20 Harmony - 20 Melody - 20 Background Music - 20

The announcement of Song/Dance should not take more than 15 seconds.

E. Quiz

Quiz will be another regular feature of the Social Science Exhibition. The quiz will be conducted in English and the theme will be "Life & Contributions of Pt. Madan Mohan Malviya and Bharat Ratna Dr. Bhim Rao Ambedkar". It will be in two rounds. The preliminary round will be a written round in which maximum five students from every region will participate. Four top scoring teams will qualify for the final round. In the final round, the selected team will be represented by two students of the concerned region. The quiz will be verbal with audio & visual round.

F. Skit

There will be a one act play/skit on any theme related to social issues (i.e. issues related to gender, population, health environment, education etc.) and the language will be English and or Hindi. The duration of the skit will be 10 to 12 minutes and this item will be covered on first two days between 6 and 8 pm. The venue Principal should ensure proper light and sound arrangement for the event based on the requirement of the skit. The concerned regions are advised in their own interest, to keep the stage resources and requirements to the minimum. Basic stage materials will be provided by the venue Principal. The best skit selected by region will be sponsored for the Nationals.

Division of marks for the event will be as under -

G. <u>Sanskrit - Shloka Recitation</u> And <u>Hindi - Kavya Path</u>

And

English - Elocution

At National level, one student of each group (classes VI to VIII & classes IX to XII) will represent the Region. The topic/theme of the selected shloka/poem may be patriotism, national integration, social cohesion, youth/women empowerment or folklore. The division of marks will be as follows:

Theme : 25
Pronunciation (Enunciation) & Diction : 25
Voice modulation & Control (Expression) : 25
Overall presentation : 25
Total : 100

Max. Time to be allotted 3 Minutes (per participant)

H. Quiz in Sanskrit

At National level the quiz will be in two rounds. The preliminary round will be a written round, in which 2 students from each Region will participate. The top scoring teams will qualify for the final. In the final round, the selected teams (of two students) will represent the Vidyalaya/Region. The final quiz will be verbal with audio & visual rounds.

I. Solo Singing Competition

- The competitions in these two events would be in two groups which are classes VI to VIII & IX to XII.
- For the participants from group VI to VIII, the theme would be folk song of the state/country allotted to the region. For the participants from group IX to XII, the theme would be Geet and Gazal (non-filmy). The region concerned will ensure that the entries are suitable in terms of decency of lyrics one boy and one girl per group should represent the Region in the solo singing competition. It should be ensured

that the students in the Solo Singing competition should not be included in the group song competition and vice-versa.

The participant may be provided background musical accompaniment by up to 3 other students but the accompanists should be from the participants already selected for other activities of the KVS National Social Science Exhibition. No additional participants should be selected specifically for the same. The division of marks will be as under:

Theme : 25
Harmony & Melody : 25
Voice Modulation & Pitch : 25
Background Music : 25

Total : 100

Max. Time to be allotted - 3 Minutes (per participant)+15 Seconds for anouncement

J. <u>On-the-Spot Painting</u>

- The competitions in these two events would be in two groups which are classes VI to VIII & IX to XII.
- Different themes would be given to the two groups of students for the On-the-spot Painting Competition. The theme will be disclosed on the same day of the competition.

Max. Time to be allotted - 90 Minutes
